

Dalmanuta's one day tours

Little Adams Peak Whole day incl. lunch €50 / boat + €25 / person	We make a 1,5 hour boat trip up the river and then we take a 1/2 hour walk to the top where we visit the 700 year old temple and enjoy the scenery. Then we get back down to the river where we have lunch and after some rest we return down the river.
Singha Radja Rainforest Tour Whole day incl. lunch €70 / car + €50 / person	We make an early start and drive north for about 3 hours. At the rainforest we spend about 3 hours walking and enjoying life. We have lunch and some rest and then we get back home.
Galle Tour Whole day incl. lunch €70 / car + €50	This tour includes visits to the most interesting sites in Galle, the Old Dutch city, and on the way there and back we visit several high class factory outlets for leathers, batiks, gems and jewelry and a sea turtle farm where we take a tour with the glass bottom boat.
Colombo Shopping Whole day incl. lunch - €70 / car + €25 / person	We visit Bare Foot, Majestic City, Odell, Rasi Silk and Crescat Boulevard. We have lunch in the city and come back to Dalmanuta around 17:00.
Brief Garden 2 hours incl. tea €15 / car + €10 / person	We visit the most famous garden in Sri Lanka, only 15 minutes away, where we spend some time admiring the very beautiful scenery, we have a cup of tea at the veranda and then we go back home.
Temple Tour 1, 5 hours €15 / car	We go visit some of our local temples and you can get a special blessing from a monk.
Fishing Trips As you like Small boat €16/ hour Big boat €50 / hour	We go up the river with our boat or out to sea with a fishing boat.
Water sports As you like Price on demand	Diving in Hikkadua or Bentota, windsurfing, waterskiing or water jetting in Bentota.
Cultural Pit Stops As we can €15 / car + voluntary gift	We go visit local Pirims, Weddings and Old Girl parties.

Dalmanuta's two and three day tours

Adams Peak & Rafting

2 days on half board

€180 / Car + €60 /

person

We leave after an early breakfast and by lunchtime we arrive at Kitugala and the Black River where the film "The Bridge over the River Kwai" was made. We first have lunch and then we get into the boats and then we let go. Two hours later we get out of the boats and continue our trip. By dinner time we arrive at Adams Peak. We have dinner and rest in our hotel before we start the climb sometime around midnight. The climb to the top takes about 5 hours and we are going to be there in time to greet the Sun at one of the most spectacular places in the world. Once we are down again we have breakfast and then we set out for Dalmanuta.

The Historic Tour Kandy with Visit to the Vedda People and the Victoria Dam

2 days on half board

€140 / Car + €120 /

person

We leave Dalmanuta at 6 am and we go north to Kandy. The road passes through the countryside and we can have a look at different cultivations. In Pinnawala we visit the elephant orphanage and have lunch. We arrive in Kandy around 17:00 and after checking in at our hotel we visit the most famous Tooth Temple before we sit down for some Devil Dancing and later on dinner. After breakfast we set out for our drive to Mahiyanganay, a 2,5 hour spectacular drive on serpentine roads with a magnificent view. Once we passed Mahiyanganay the road continues into the jungle and our goal, Dambana. This is where we still can find and meet the Vedda people, Sri Lankas own aboriginals. Most people dress in leaves and wears traditional weapons like axes and bows. We will probably be offered to taste there bee honey and special fruits in place for some donations. On the way back to Dalmanuta we stop for lunch in Mahiyanganay and a visit to the Victoria Dam.

The Nature Tour with Yala Safari, Galle and Hikkadua

2 days on half board

€200/ Car & Jeep + €100

/ person

We leave Dalmanuta at 6 am and head south on the Galle road. We stop for a visit at the Turtle Farm and by the coral reef in Hikkaduwa. You can go snorkeling if you like, but you can also see it all from the glass bottom boat. Once we are back on land we continue to Mathara where we will visit the Grand Temple and the Pole Fishermen. We stop in Tangalle for a stroll on the beautiful beach and we arrive at our hotel in Tisemaharana in time lunch. At 3 pm we get into the Jeeps and the safari starts. For the next four hours we will be back in the original nature hoping to see Elephant, deer, monkey, crocodile, wild boar, peacock and many other birds and if we are very lucky we might also see leopard and black bear as they come to the water at sunset. We will stop and get out of the jeep for a while down at the beach before we get back to "civilization" for our dinner at the hotel. After breakfast we leave for Galle where we will take a walk at the waterfront, visiting the old fort and have lunch. Leaving Galle we can stop for visits at the moon stone mine, the batik and the wood carving factory before we are heading back to Dalmanuta.

The Royal Tour with Anaratnapura, Polonaruwa, Sigiriya and Dambulla

2 days on half board
€180 / Car + €150 / person

We start at 6 am driving north through the countryside where we can see many different cultivations. We will have lunch on the way and arrive in Anaratnapura in the afternoon. Anaratnapura was the most important city for Sri Lankas ancient royal dynasties and here we will visit 8 different sites with historic or religious interest. After about two hours we go on to Polonaruwa where we check in at our hotel and eat dinner. Polonaruwa was also an important city for the royal family and here we will visit the archeological excavation of more than 200 acres. When we are done we go on to Sigiriya, the Royal Rock, which we climb for about two hours. Back down we continue our trip to Dambulla where we visit the Golden Temple before we return back to Dalmanuta.

Kandy & Nuwara Elia

3 days on half board
€210 / Car + €170 / person

We leave Dalmanuta at 6 am and we go north for Kandy. The road passes through the lush countryside and we stop to have a look at different cultivations. In Pinnawala we visit the elephant orphanage and we have lunch. We arrive in Kandy around 17:00 and after checking in at our hotel we meet up for dinner. After breakfast we leave our things in the hotel and set out for Matale and its Hindu temple. After our visit there we go on to Sigiriya, where we are going to climb the Royal Rock. Back down again we eat lunch before we continue to Dambulla for a visit to the Cave Temple and the Golden Buddha. On the way back to Kandy we do a short stop at a wood carving and a batik factory. Back in Kandy we pay a visit to the most famous Tooth Temple before we sit down for some devil dancing and later on dinner. After breakfast we leave the hotel for Nuwara Elia which was once the summer capital of the British administration and famous for its architecture and its tea plantations. Now its time to take a swim and we go to The Hat, two impressive waterfalls carrying the Ganga down towards the coast. We stop for lunch in Kithugala, where the film "The Bridge over the River Kwai" was shot, and we will be back to Dalmanuta in time for dinner.

Elephant and Gem Tour

2 days on half board
€180 / Car & Jeep + €90 / person

We leave Dalmanuta at 6 am and we go north. We travel through the country side where we can see many different plantations. We stop for lunch in Ratnapura and then we go on to Udawalawa where we check in at our hotel. At 3 pm we get into the safari jeeps and enter the park where we will be able to see many elephants. When we come back to the hotel we will eat dinner. After breakfast we go to Ratnapura, the Gem capital of Sri Lanka, where we will visit the Gem Museum. After lunch we start the drive back home to Dalmanuta.
